Veteran ID Cards Available for Monmouth County Residents

Cards are issued at the County Clerk's Freehold Office, Neptune Monmouth County Connection and Mobile County Connection at the Monmouth Mall.

In order to obtain a card, applicants must bring in their NJ Driver's License and DD-214 "Report of Separation" Form. The DD-214 must list the applicant's "Character of Service" as "Honorable." After presenting the necessary documents, applicants will fill out a simple form and have their photograph taken for the ID card.

Note: The Monmouth County Clerk's Office only issues Veteran's ID cards to Monmouth County residents. If you live in another county, please see your County Clerk.
